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What is a Reassign Action?

A district supports the **thoughtful transfer of students** to high-performing A/B-rated schools after the closure of a campus. This is done by communicating with families, providing school options to students, and allocating resources to the students' new schools to **ensure learning acceleration support and a sense of belonging** for transferred students.

Consider Reassign If:

- A campus has chronic underperformance, and
- The district has nearby A/B campuses that can absorb more students AND deliver a great student experience.
- The district has too many campuses and this is impeding the ability to deliver a high-quality experience for every student

Why Reassign Students to Higher Performing Schools?

- The district determines that students and families would be best served at high-performing campuses.
- The district is able to create space at existing high-performing schools, where students' experience will be vastly improved.
