



## What is a Redesign Action?

A Redesign Action supports a school leader to develop and implement a whole-school model that meets the community's needs. The campus **may** keep the same leader, staff, and students, but substantially changes instructional, staffing, scheduling, and professional development practices to improve student outcomes. The specifics of a Redesign Action plan should **vary based on student outcome data, campus and community needs, and district characteristics**.

"We feel we have the right team in place, but the campus must change the way it does business."

## **Consider Redesign If:**

- A campus has chronic underperformance, but low turnover among a staff eager to learn and grow.
- Families want a different type of school model.

## Why Redesign a Struggling Campus?

- Boost academic performance through High-Quality Instructional Materials, extended day or year, and accelerated instruction tailored to student needs.
- Create a holistic and nurturing learning environment through enhanced support services such as counseling, tutoring, and extracurricular activities.
- Promote transparent accountability by setting clear goals, benchmarks, and formative assessments.
